- To be provided with a **RI EN NO ICE** of investigation and the nature of the complaint filed against you.
- To a **PROMP AND HORO. GH** investigation of the allegations.
- To PAR ICIPA E OR DECLINE O PAR ICIPA E in the investigation process. However, an investigation may still occur and decisions made on the available information.
- To an O. COME BA ED OLEL ON INFORMA ION gathered during the investigation. Such information shall be credible, relevant, based in fact, and without prejudice.
- To not have IRRELE AN prior sexual history considered as information in the investigation.
- To be NO IFIED IN RI ING of the outcome of the investigation and any sanctions that have been issued.
